## Baptism of Anne Girard

The baptism of Gilles and Anne Girard took place on the 3 Feb 1630 at St-Cyr-du-Vaudreuil, Eure, Normandy. Their parents were Michel Girard and Francoise de Graffard. This is the same Anne Girard, Fille du Roi, that married Nicolas Daudelin on the 22 Oct 1665 in Chateau-Richer, Quebec, Canada.

In doing further research on Anne's mother, I have found that she is part of a minor Noble family from the area. I have compiled records on Anne's grandparents, their children, the birth and death of her mother, and death of her Grandfather. On Anne's father I have found all his children by his 3 marriages, his last two marriages and his death. On Anne, I have found the baptism and death of an illegitimate daughter prior to her arriving in Quebec.

The source of my information comes from St-Cyr-du-Vaudreuil parish records, found on the LDS film 0346496. This research was done by:

The attached files are for the Extended family of Anne Girard, her parents and grandparents, marriages and deaths that were available.

With the record of the illegitimate child of Anne Girard and her death, you will notice that it is rather detailed in the information that it gives. This record was not at all like the others in the same time period as it was extremely detailed and very carefully written. The others just gave the name of the child, parents and god parents. I can only assume that because of the status of her mother, that this record was so detailed. This record also confirms the name of Michel second wife, Anne's half brother and also the profession of Anne's father.

Using the profession of Michel, I was able to confirm that I had the correct Michel for the third marriage to Marie Osman.

I have begun to do some research on the de Graffard suier de Mailly family, but that will be a while in coming. On the baptismal record of the mother of Anne, Françoise de Graffard, you will notice a child, daughter baptised to the same parents a month later. This was a bit of a confusion, and I can only assume that she was Françoise twin sister and for some reason was baptised at a later date. Perhaps you know the reason and could pass it on to me.

Bonjour Dominique,

I have attached the following files of the research that I have done on Anne Girard, Fille du Roi from the parish of St Cyr-du-Vaulreuil. I will send all my files in two Emails so that I can alleviate any server problems you could have on your end.

All the records that I have found come from the LDS film # 346496, the parish records for St Cyr -du-Vaulreuil, Eure, Normandy, France. The film begins with Oct 1586 to Nov 1589, then there is a gap and starts up again 1595 , gap and begins with 1597. The earlier records are only Baptisms and the first death I was able to find was in 1619. The marriages and deaths are not there on a regular basis till the later 1620's early 1630's. Because of the gaps in years and lack of acutal records, it is impossible to verify exact dates of some births , marriages and deaths.

I have attached all the records that I was able to find for the children of Michel Girard, who is the father of Anne Girard. I have been very careful to make sure that I have the correct Michel as there were two in this parish in the 1630's. I have been as detailed as possible in my research, but I am by no means an expert in French Genealogy. If you see any errors that I have made e.g. dates, please feel free to correct me.
