Sébastien Hodiau / Odiau, his wife Marie Lemonnier / LeMousnier, and their daughter Urbaine came from the parish of St-Thomas in La Flèche, department of Sarthe, France. The baptism / birth of both Sébastien and Marie have not been found, but their family names are common in that parish and town.

Sébastien Odiau married Marie Lemonnier on 30 May 1637 at St-Thomas.¹
