St-Rémy.] It is not known what became of this family. Nicolas is not mentioned on the list of either crew members or passengers of Le Noir. No other records have been found in Québec concerning Michel Alix, Nicolas Alix or the other crew members who were confirmed at Notre-Dame de Québec on 3 June 1664.

Antoine Forestier (Fortier)

Antoine was baptized 26 June 1644 at St-Jacques in Dieppe. His parents, Noël Fortier and Marthe Golle, were married 26 May 1638 at St-Rémy in Dieppe. (DJ, p. 429) Godbout also indicates that banns were read at St-Jacques on 19 and 25 April and 1 May 1638. Their first child, Marthe, was baptized at St-Rémy on 8 May 1639 and was buried on 20 June 1639 at St-Jacques. (Godbout, "Notules généalogiques".) Antoine's brother, Noël, was baptized 17 October 1640 at St-Jacques; his sister Catherine was baptized 1 November 1747 at St-Jacques.
