

Baptism of François LeGantier, *sieur de LaVallée et de Rané/Rasné*

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François LeGantier, *sieur de LaVallée et de Rané/Rasné*, son of Louis LeGantier, *escuyer, sieur de la Vallée*, and Marguerite de Bongard, was baptized 18 October 1665, at the age of about 18 months, in the parish of Châtillon, in the canton of LaChartre-sur-le-Loir, *arrondissement* and bishopric of Le Mans, Maine (Sarthe), France. He was a lieutenant in the detachment of the Marines and married **Barbe Loisel** 28 November 1689 in Montréal. François LeGantier was godfather to **Marie Angélique Bontron** 5 July 1707 in Ste Anne du Détroit. He was a godfather again on 21 October 1707 to **François Émard**. On 7 November 1707 he was godfather to **Jacques de Marsac**. His wife **Barbe Loisel** was a godmother on 28 March 1709 to **François de Lamothe Cadillac**; on 3 May 1709 she was godmother to **Pierre Chalut**. Barbe Loisel was a godmother to **Antoine Langlois** on 13 November 1709. On 18 August 1710 François LeGantier was godfather to **Louis**, the son of **AK8emes8iss8ré** and **Attaristik8pé**, *renards* [Fox]. François LeGantier was buried at Détroit 13 November 1710. Barbe Loisel married **François Fafard dit Delorme** at Détroit 30 December 1713. [Jetté, 412, 695; Ste Anne du Détroit register] – In register
